ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A5 Trunk Road (Gobowen, Shropshire) (Temporary
Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - 30th July 2012

Coming into force - - 6th August 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that trunk road, near Gobowen in the County of Shropshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Gobowen, Shropshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 6th August 2012.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the northbound carriageway of the A5 between points 415 metres south and 390 metres north of its junction with the road leading to Hengoed at Pleasant Groves;

"the works period" means the period starting at 19:00 hours on Monday 13th August 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the A5 at its junction with the road leading to Hengoed at Pleasant Groves.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of –

- a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;
- b) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and
- c) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
