ROAD TRAFFIC

The A458 Trunk Road (Rowton to Wollaston, Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A458 Trunk Road ("the A458"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Rowton and Wollaston in the County of Shropshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A458 Trunk Road (Rowton to Wollaston, Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 27th August 2012.

2. In this Order –

"the trunk road"	means eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A458 between its junction with Rowton Avenue east of Rowton and its junction with the unnamed road leading to Orchard school west of Wollaston;
"layby"	means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a traffic sign of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the sign is placed; and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 06.00 hours on Monday 3rd September 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby situated adjacent to the westbound carriageway of the trunk road approximately 350 metres east of its junction with Marche Lane.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave any side road leading to or from the trunk road.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works; or
- (iv) proceeding in the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
