ROAD TRAFFIC

The A30 Trunk Road (Upottery to Monkton, Near Honiton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 24th January 2012

Coming into force - - 30th January 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road ("the A30"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Honiton in the County of Devon should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Upottery to Monkton, Near Honiton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 30th January 2012.

2. In this Order -

"the A30" means the A30 near Upottery from a point at the centre of its junction with Viney Lane at Cotleigh Crossing to a point 500 metres north of the centre of that Junction;

"layby" means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(**b**); and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

"the works" mean improvements to signs, lining, junction visibility and surfacing;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Tuesday 31st January 2012 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to an article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during a works period:
 - (a) cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the A30;
 - (b) cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or remain in the layby adjacent to the A30 northbound situated north of its junction with Hedgend Road, near Monkton.

- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
 - (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works or for winter maintenance purposes.
- **5.** The provisions of article 3(a) shall not apply to a vehicle proceeding to or from premises that are accessible from and only from the A30.
