**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A38 Trunk Road (Glynn Valley, Near Bodmin) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - - *29th August 2012*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *1st September 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Turfdown Roundabout and Twelve Woods Roundabout near Bodmin in Cornwall should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Glynn Valley, Near Bodmin) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 1st September 2012.

**2.** In this Order –

“the A38” means the A38 from the eastern edge of the Turfdown Roundabout, Bodmin, to the western edge of the Twelve Woods Roundabout (junction with the A390);

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b); and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“the works” mean drainage, geotechnical and resurfacing works together with routine maintenance works such as sign cleaning, gully emptying, tree works, road studs and white lining;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Sunday 2nd September 2012 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A38.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or remain in the laybys adjacent to:

- (a) the A38 eastbound situated 600 metres east of the Drift Lane Junction and opposite the North Lane Junction;
- (b) the A38 westbound situated 250 metres east of the Drift Lane Junction and 150 metres east of the Holt Road Junction.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works.

6. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to a vehicle proceeding to or from Bodmin Parkway Station or premises that are accessible from and only from the A38.
