The A259 Trunk Road (Rye) (30 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2012

Made - - - - 3rd September 2012

Coming into force - - 14th September 2012

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 82(2), 83(1), 84(1)(a) and (2) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (Rye) (30 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 14th September 2012.
- **2.** The length of the A259 Trunk Road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall be a restricted road for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
 - 3. The Trunk Roads (40 m.p.h. Speed Limit) (No. 26) Order 1970(b) is hereby revoked.

THE SCHEDULE

Length of the Trunk Road subject to a speed limit of 30 miles per hour

Both carriageways of the A259 Trunk Road (Winchelsea Road and New Winchelsea Road) near Rye between points 790 metres south and 48 metres north of Harbour Road, a total distance of approximately 838 metres.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order imposes a 30mph speed limit on a length of the A259 Trunk Road near Rye as described in the Schedule and supersedes a temporary Order to this effect. The existing 40mph speed limit Order is revoked.
