The A38 Trunk Road (Woodpecker Junction, Near South Brent) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road ("the A38") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the District of South Hams in the County of Devon should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public during the Tour of Britain Cycle Race through the junction.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Woodpecker Junction, Near South Brent) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 13th September 2012.

2. In this Order –

"the slip road " mean the eastbound exit slip road of the A38 at Woodpecker Junction, near South Brent

"the period of danger" means the period starting at 13.15 hours on Saturday 15th September 2012 and ending when the likelihood of danger to the public from the Tour of Britain cycle race is over.

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the period of danger, cause any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes
- (b) or proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.
