ROAD TRAFFIC

The M65 Motorway (Junction 1 Westbound Carriageway) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 30th August 2012

Coming into force - - 17th September 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M65 Motorway, is satisfied that traffic on a section of that motorway in the District of Chorley in the County of Lancashire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M65 Motorway (Junction 1 Westbound Carriageway) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 17th September 2012.

2. In this Order:

"the motorway" means the M65 Motorway at Junction 1;

"the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road" means the last point where the slip road leaves the carriageway of the motorway;

"the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road" means the first point where the slip road joins the carriageway of the motorway;

"works" means vehicle safety barrier works on the motorway;

"the works period" means one night between 2200 hours and 0500 hours starting on Tuesday 18 September 2012 and ending on Wednesday 19 September 2012. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the length of carriageway" means the westbound carriageway of the motorway from the tip of the nosing of the exit slip road at Junction 1 to the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road at Junction 1.

- 3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway.
- 4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
