## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The M5 Motorway (Junctions 3 to 4) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

*Made - - - 10th September 2012* 

Coming into force - - 17th September 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M5 Motorway ("the M5") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway and on several of those connecting roads, between Junctions 3 and 4 in the Metropolitan Borough of Sandwell and the County of Worcestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M5 Motorway (Junctions 3 to 4) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 17th September 2012.

## **2.** In this Order:

"the motorway"

means -

- (i) the southbound carriageway of the M5 between its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 3 and its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 4;
- (ii) the northbound carriageway of the M5 between its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 4 and its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 3;

"a slip road"

means -

- (i) the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the M5 at Junction 3;
- (ii) the slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the M5 at Junction 3;
- (iii) the slip road leading from the southbound carriageway of the M5 at Junction 4;
- (iv) the slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the M5 at Junction 4;

- (v) the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the M5 at Junction 4;
- (vi) the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the M5 at Junction 4; and
- (v) the slip roads leading to and from the southbound and northbound carriageways of the M5 at Frankley Motorway Service Area;

"the works period"

means the period starting at 21.00 hours on Monday 24th September 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the motorway or a slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle
  - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
  - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
  - (iii) being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
