**The A38 Trunk Road (Drybridge Junction to Marley Head
Junction, Near South Brent) (Temporary Prohibition and
Restriction of Traffic) (Number 2) Order 2011
Variation Order 2012**

Made - - - - - *26th January 2012*
Coming into force - - - - - *28th January 2012*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of, and paragraph 27(1) of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf:

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Drybridge Junction to Marley Head Junction, Near South Brent) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) (Number 2) Order 2011 Variation Order 2012 and shall come into force on 28th January 2012.
2. The A38 Trunk Road (Drybridge Junction to Marley Head Junction, Near South Brent) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) (Number 2) Order 2011(b) is hereby varied by substituting for the words “the A30” in articles 3(a), (b) and (d), the following words – “the A38”.
