**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A11 Trunk Road (South of Nine Mile Hill) and the A14  
Trunk Road (Between Junction 35 and Junction 37)  
(Cambridgeshire) Lay-bys  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - - *24th September 2012*  
*Coming into force* - - - - - *1st October 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A11 Trunk Road (“the A11”) and the A14 Trunk Road (“the A14”) is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A11 Trunk Road (South of Nine Mile Hill) and the A14 Trunk Road (Between Junction 35 and Junction 37) (Cambridgeshire) Lay-bys (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 1st October 2012.

2. In this Order –

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b); and in this definition “carriageway” means a way constituting or comprised in a trunk road (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“works” mean VMS gantry maintenance;

“the works period” means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 8th October 2012 and ending when the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter the lay-by adjacent to the –

- (i) northbound carriageway of the A11 situated 900 metres south,
- (ii) eastbound carriageway of the A14 situated 1800 metres west, or

(iii) westbound carriageway of the A14 situated 2300 metres east,  
of the centre point of the A1303 overbridge at Nine Mile Hill.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works.
