ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 Motorway (Junction 11) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 17th September 2012

Coming into force - - 24th September 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway (“the M6”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on four of those connecting roads in the County of Staffordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junction 11) (Slip Roads) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 24th September 2012.

2. In this Order:

“a slip road” means the slip road leading –

- i) to the northbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 11;
- ii) from the northbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 11;
- iii) to the southbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 11; and
- iv) from the southbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 11;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Saturday 29th September 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform, or
- (iii) being used by a traffic officer in uniform.
