ROAD TRAFFIC

The A120 Trunk Road (Ramsey, Tendring, Essex) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A120 Trunk Road ("the A120"), is satisfied that traffic on several lengths of that road in the District of Tendring in the County of Essex should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A120 Trunk Road (Ramsey, Tendring, Essex) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 22nd October 2012.

2. In this Order –

"the roundabout" means the circulatory carriageway of the A120/B1352 Ramsey Roundabout;

"the first length of trunk road" means the –

- (a) eastbound carriageway of the A120 from a point 230 metres west of its junction with, to its junction with, the roundabout, and
- (b) westbound carriageway of the A120 from a point 210 metres east of its junction with, to its junction with, the roundabout;

"the second length of trunk road" means the A120 between points 230 metres west and 210 metres east of its junctions with the roundabout;

"works" mean resurfacing of the carriageway and refreshment of road markings to Ramsey Roundabout;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Tuesday 23rd October 2012 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road or the roundabout.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the second length of trunk road.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.

6. Nothing in article 4 shall apply to a vehicle –

- (a) being used for, or in connection with, the works or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes,
- (b) being used for, police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to a vehicle being used for a purpose specified in paragraph (b) of this article or to any vehicle falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
