## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 62, Carville) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour and 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012

Made - - - 18th October 2012

Coming into force - 28th October 2012

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway, the A690 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the County of Durham, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road and some of those connecting roads should be restricted because bridge joint renewal and routine maintenance works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 62, Carville) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour and 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 28th October 2012.
- **2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 29th October 2012 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding:
  - (i) 50 miles per hour in the A1(M) Motorway northbound or southbound exit or entry slip roads at Junction 62 (Carville); or
  - (ii) 40 miles per hour in the circulatory carriageway of the A690 Trunk Road at Carville Interchange.
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.
- **4.** No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(**b**) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
