ROAD TRAFFIC

The A27 Trunk Road (Upper Brighton Road, Worthing) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made---22nd October 2012Coming into force-10th November 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted and prohibited on lengths of that road and on some connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Upper Brighton Road, Worthing) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 10th November 2012.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A27 Trunk Road (Upper Brighton Road) near Worthing in the County of West Sussex;

"lay-by" means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(**b**);

"an A27 lay-by" means the lay-by in the westbound carriageway of the trunk road 60 metres west of Busticle Lane;

"the first length of trunk road" means the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road from its junction with Lyons Way to its junction with Church Lane;

"the second length of trunk road" means the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road from its junction with Church Lane to its junction with Dankton Lane;

"a third length of trunk road" means both carriageways of the trunk road from its junction with Dankton Lane to its junction with Busticle Lane/Halewick Lane;

"a side road" means -

- (i) Busticle Lane at its junction with the westbound carriageway of the trunk road, or
- (ii) Halewick Lane at its junction with the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road road;

"works" mean drainage, electrical, resurfacing and all associated work on the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 12th November 2012 or on any subsequent day until 9th May 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period -

- (a) cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in, or wait on, an A27 lay-by; or
- (b) cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a third length of trunk road or a side road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding -

- (a) 50 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road when that speed is indicated by a traffic sign; or
- (b) 40 miles per hour on the second length of trunk road when that speed is indicated by a traffic sign.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. (1) Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
- (e) a vehicle proceeding in a third length of trunk road or a side road to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that trunk road or that slip road, to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.

(2) Nothing in article 4 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations $2011(\mathbf{a})$ when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
