The A5 Trunk Road (Watling Street, Staffordshire) (Temporary 30 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Gailey Reservoirs in the County of Staffordshire, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Watling Street, Staffordshire) (Temporary 30 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 9th November 2012.

2. In this Order –

"the trunk road"	means the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A5 from a point 450 metres east of Vicarage Road to a point 200 metres west of its junction with Four Crosses Lane and Poplar Lane;		
"the works period"	means the period starting at 10:00 hours on Friday 16th November 2012 and ending when the said works have

been completed;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for special forces, police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
