## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The M42 Motorway (Junction 4) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 2nd November 2012

Coming into force - 9th November 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M42 Motorway ("the M42") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway and one of those connecting roads in the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M42 Motorway (Junction 4) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 9th November 2012.

## 2. In this Order -

"the motorway" means the northbound carriageway of the M42 from a

point 150 metres south of the centreline of Tinkers Lane underbridge to a point 40 metres north of the centreline of the southern bridge of the M42/A34/A3400 roundabout

junction (M42 Junction 4);

"the slip road" means the slip road leading from the northbound

carriageway of the M42 at Junction 4;

"the works period" means the period starting at 19:30 hours on Friday 16th

November 2012 and ending when the said works have

been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the motorway.

- **4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the slip road.
- **5.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
  - **6.** The provisions of:
    - (a) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -
      - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or
      - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
    - (b) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes; and
    - (c) article 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works or by, or with the permission, of a traffic officer in uniform.
