ROAD TRAFFIC

The A30 Trunk Road (Okehampton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road ("the A30") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and some of those connecting roads at Okehampton, in the District of West Devon in the County of Devon, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Okehampton) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 11th January 2012.

2. In this Order –

"the A30" means (i) the eastbound carriageway of the A30 at Okehampton from the tip of the nosing of the eastbound exit slip road at the Sourton Cross Junction to the tip of the nosing of the eastbound entry slip road at the Tongue End Junction; and (ii) the westbound carriageway of the A30 from the tip of the nosing of the westbound exit slip road at the Tongue End Junction to the tip of the nosing of the westbound entry slip road at the Sourton Cross Junction;

"the slip roads" mean (i) the westbound entry slip road at the A30 Tongue End Junction; (ii) the eastbound entry slip road at the A30 Sourton Cross Junction; and the westbound entry slip road at the A30 Meldon Junction;

"tip of the nosing" means the first point where an entry slip road joins the carriageway of a trunk road or the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

"the works" mean patching and studding works;

"a works period" means a period of 12 hours starting at 18.00 hours on Friday 13th January 2012 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A30 and the slip roads.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

(c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works.
