ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (Tamworth, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 9th November 2012

Coming into force - - 16th November 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads, near Tamworth in the County of Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Tamworth, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 16th November 2012.

2. In this Order:

"the slip road" means the slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway

of the A5 at Ventura Park Interchange, Tamworth;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Tuesday 20th

November 2012 and ending when the said works have

been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
 - 5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
