# The Goods Vehicles (Licensing of Operators) (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 2012

Made	7th February 2012
Laid before Parliament	13th February 2012
Coming into force	1st April 2012

The Secretary of State makes these Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 45(1) and 57(1) and (7) of the Goods Vehicles (Licensing of Operators) Act  $1995(\mathbf{a})$  and by virtue of the Department for Transport (Fees) Order  $2009(\mathbf{b})$ .

Representative organisations have been consulted in accordance with section 57(12) of that Act.

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Goods Vehicles (Licensing of Operators) (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 2012 and come into force on 1st April 2012.

#### **Amendment of Regulations**

**2.**—(1) The Goods Vehicles (Licensing of Operators) (Fees) Regulations 1995(c) are amended as follows.

(2) The following substitutions are made in the Schedule —

- (a) in relation to fee number (i), in column 3, "£254" for "£250";
- (b) in relation to fee number (ii), in column 3, "£397" for "£391";
- (c) in relation to fee number (iii), in column 3, "£397" for "£391";
- (d) in relation to fee number (iv), in column 3, "£68" for "£66".

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

#### (This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the fees which are payable under the Goods Vehicles (Licensing of Operators) (Fees) Regulations 1995 in relation to goods vehicle operator licences granted under the Goods Vehicles (Licensing of Operators) Act 1995.

Fee changes, together with the percentage increase, are shown in the table below. The fees were last increased on 20th April 2009.

	Old Fee	New Fee	Percentage Increase
Fee with licence application or application for a licence variation	£250	£254	1.6%
Fee for the issue of a licence	£391	£397	1.5%
Fee for the continuation in force of a licence	£391	£397	1.5%
Fee for the issue of an interim licence or interim direction	£66	£68	3.0%
