ROAD TRAFFIC

The A63 Trunk Road (Priory Way Interchange to Western Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A63 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the East Riding of Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because bridge repair works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A63 Trunk Road (Priory Way Interchange to Western Interchange) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 7th December 2012.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 9 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Saturday 8th December 2012 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A63 Trunk Road:

- (i) eastbound carriageway between the nose of the eastbound exit slip road at the A15 Western Interchange and the nose of the eastbound entry slip road at Priory Way Interchange, a distance of approximately 2500 metres;
- (ii) westbound carriageway between the nose of the westbound exit slip road at Priory Way Interchange and the nose of the westbound entry slip road at the Western Interchange, a distance of approximately 2500 metres;
- (iii) eastbound entry and westbound exit slip roads at Western Interchange; and
- (iv) eastbound exit and westbound entry slip roads at Priory Way Interchange.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
