## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A2 Trunk Road (Guston Roundabout – Dover Eastern Docks Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A2 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act  $1984(\mathbf{a})$ , hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A2 Trunk Road (Guston Roundabout – Dover Eastern Docks Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 12th January 2013 and shall apply for a period of eighteen months.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A2 Trunk Road near Dover in the County of Kent;

"the length of carriageway" means both carriageways of the trunk road (Jubilee Way) from its junction with the A258 near Guston to its junction with the A20 at Dover Eastern Docks;

"works" mean joint replacement work at Eastcliff Viaduct;

"a first works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Friday 18th January 2013 or on any subsequent day until 11th July 2014;

"a second works period" means a period of 34 hours starting at 2000 hours on Saturday 19th January 2013 or on any subsequent Saturday until Saturday 5th July 2014.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a first works period or a second works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or

(d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
