ROAD TRAFFIC

The A49 Trunk Road (Bayston Hill, Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made	-	-	5th December 2012
Coming into force		-	12th December 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road ("the A49"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, near Bayston Hill in the County of Shropshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A49 Trunk Road (Bayston Hill, Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 12th December 2012.

2. In this Order –

"the trunk road"	means the southbound and northbound carriageways of the A49 between its roundabout junction with the A5 (Dobbies Island) and its junction with the unnamed road 600 metres south of Burgs Lane;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Wednesday 19th December 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the trunk road at its junction with -

(a) Sharpstone Lane;

(b) Lower Pulley Lane;

(c) Cross Lane;

(d) Lyth Hill Road;

- (e) The Common;
- (f) Cross Roads;
- (g) Burgs Lane; and
- (h) Kendricks Bank.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 6. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
 - (c) being used in connection with the said works; or
 - (d) proceeding in the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
