ROAD TRAFFIC

The A12 Trunk Road (Junction 29 Crown Interchange, Colchester, Essex) Southbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made---31st December 2012Coming into force-7th January 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road ("the A12"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Essex should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Junction 29 Crown Interchange, Colchester, Essex) Southbound (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 7th January 2013.

2. In this Order –

"tip of the nosing" means, as indicated by the road markings on the carriageway, the first point where an entry slip road joins, or the last point where an exit slip road leaves, the carriageway of the trunk road;

"the trunk road" means the southbound carriageway of the A12 between the tips of the nosings of the exit slip road to and entry slip road from the A120/A1232 Crown Interchange (Junction 29), Colchester;

"works" mean concrete condition survey to the soffit of Kilnwood Bridge;

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 14th January 2013 or on any subsequent day until the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle –

- (a) being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes,
- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
