ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A64 Trunk Road (Hopgrove Roundabout to Whitwell)
(Temporary 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012**

Made - - - - *3rd January 2012*

Coming into force - - *8th January 2012*

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A64 Trunk Road and connecting roads, in the District of York, in the County of North Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road should be restricted because verge hardening works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A64 Trunk Road (Hopgrove Roundabout to Whitwell) (Temporary 40 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 8th January 2012.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 9th January 2012 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in the A64 Trunk Road from its junction with the A1036 Hopgrove Roundabout eastwards for a distance of 9900 metres.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police officer in uniform.

4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
