ROAD TRAFFIC

The M62 Motorway (Junction 36 and Junction 35) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 16th February 2012

Coming into force - - 26th February 2012

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M62 Motorway and connecting roads, in the East Riding of Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway and some of those connecting roads should be prohibited because carriageway lining works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the M62 Motorway (Junction 36 and Junction 35) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 26th February 2012.
- **2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 27th February 2012 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the:
 - (i) M62 Motorway westbound carriageway from the nose of the westbound exit slip road at Junction 36 (Airmyn) westwards for a distance of 1145 metres;
 - (ii) link road connecting the M62 Motorway westbound carriageway to the M18 Motorway southbound carriageway at Langham Interchange (the M62 Motorway Junction 35 and the M18 Motorway Junction 7);
 - (iii) link road connecting the M18 Motorway northbound carriageway to the M62 Motorway westbound carriageway at Langham Interchange; and
 - (iv) dedicated link road connecting to the M62 Motorway westbound entry slip road at Junction 36.
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
 - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
