## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A5 Trunk Road (A4146 Kelly's Kitchen Roundabout, Milton Keynes) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012

Made - - - - 20th February 2012

Coming into force - - 27th February 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5") is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in Milton Keynes should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order: -

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (A4146 Kelly's Kitchen Roundabout, Milton Keynes) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 27th February 2012.
  - 2. In this Order -
    - "the trunk road" means the A5 between points 1700 metres north and 1700 metres south of its junctions with the A4146 Kelly's Kitchen Roundabout including the circulatory carriageway of that roundabout;
    - "works" mean signalisation of the A5/A4146 Kelly's Kitchen Roundabout;
    - "the works period" means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 5th March 2012 and ending when the works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the trunk road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs.
  - 5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to a vehicle
    - (a) being used in connection with the works or for winter service maintenance or traffic officer purposes,

- (b) being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes, or
- (c) proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or traffic officer in uniform;

and nothing in article 3 shall apply to a vehicle being used for a purpose specified in paragraph (b) of this article or to a vehicle falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
