ROAD TRAFFIC

The A52 and A5111 Trunk Roads (Spondon, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road ("the A52"), the A5111 Trunk Road ("A5111") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads, at Spondon in the County of Derbyshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A52 and A5111 Trunk Roads (Spondon, Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 27th February 2012.

2. In this Order –

"a slip road"

means the slip road–

- (i) leading from the westbound carriageway of the A52 to the A5111 (Raynesway);
- (ii) leading to the eastbound carriageway of the A52 from the A5111 (Raynesway);
- (iii) leading to the eastbound carriageway of the A52 from its roundabout junction with the A6005 (Spondon Roundabout); and
- (iv) leading from the westbound carriageway of the A52 to its roundabout junction with the A6005 (Spondon Roundabout);

"the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Sunday 4th March 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in a slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to leave the eastbound carriageway of the A52 at its junction with Lodge Lane.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle –

i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;

ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or iii) being used in connection with the said works.
