ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (Mancetter Roundabout, Atherstone, Warwickshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2012

 Made
 28th February 2012

 Coming into force
 6th March 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5"), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road, at Mancetter near Atherstone in the County of Warwickshire, should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Mancetter Roundabout, Atherstone, Warwickshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 6th March 2012.

2. In this Order:

"Mancetter Roundabout" means the circulatory carriageway of the A5 at its junction

with the B4116 Watling Street, the B4111 Harpers Lane

and Carlyon Road;

"the first length of trunk road" means the A5 between a point 100 metres north and a

point 200 metres south of Mancetter Roundabout;

"the second length of trunk road" means the eastbound carriageway of the A5 from a point

500 metres north of Mancetter Roundabout to a point 100

metres north of that roundabout;

"the works period" means the period starting at 22:00 hours on Tuesday 13th

March 2011 and ending when the said works have been

completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road or Mancetter Roundabout.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the second length of trunk road.
- **5.** The provisions of article 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
 - **6.** The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
 - (iii) being used for special forces purposes.
