ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A46 Trunk Road (Evesham, Worcestershire) (Temporary
Restriction of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - 2nd March 2012

Coming into force - - 9th March 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Evesham in the County of Worcestershire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Evesham, Worcestershire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 9th March 2012.

2. In this Order –

“the first length of trunk road” means the A46 between points –

- (a) 350 metres north of its roundabout junction with the B4035 and 350 metres south of its roundabout junction with the A44 Broadway Road including the circulatory carriageways of those roundabouts; and
- (b) 400 metres north and 350 metres south of its roundabout junction with the A44 at Twyford including the circulatory carriageway of that roundabout;

“the second length of trunk road” means the A46 between points –

- (a) 150 metres north of its roundabout junction with the B4035 and 150 metres south of its roundabout junction with the A44 Broadway Road including the circulatory carriageways of those roundabouts; and

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1

(b) 200 metres north and 150 metres south of its roundabout junction with the A44 at Twyford including the circulatory carriageway of that roundabout;

“the works period”

means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Saturday 10th March 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the second length of trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on those lengths of road are displayed.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
