## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

## The A5 Trunk Road and M6 Toll Motorway (Churchbridge, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made		-	-	2nd March 2012
Coming in	to force	2 -	-	9th March 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5"), M6 Toll Road (the "M6 Toll") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of some of those connecting roads in the County of Staffordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road and M6 Toll Motorway (Churchbridge, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 9th March 2012.

## **2.** In this Order:

"the first roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway at the roundabout junction of the A5 with the A460 and A34, south of Cannock;
"the second roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway at the roundabout junction of the A5 with the A34 and the slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the M6 Toll;
"the slip road"	means the slip road leading from the northbound carriageway of the M6 Toll at Junction T7; and
"the works period"	means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Sunday 11th March 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first roundabout, the second roundabout or the slip road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
