## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The M1 Motorway (Junction 24a) (Northbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 5th March 2012 Coming into force - - 12th March 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway ("the M1") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads, in the County of Leicestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as The M1 Motorway (Junction 24a) (Northbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 12th March 2012.

## 2. In this Order -

"the slip road" means the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway

of the M1 at Junction 24a;

"the works period" means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 19th

March 2012 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -
  - (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;

(b)	proceeding at the direction	ı of,	or	with	the	permission	of,	a	police	constable,	or	traffic

(c) being used for or in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
