## ROAD TRAFFIC

## The A49 Trunk Road (Leominster to Ludlow) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - - 2nd March 2012

Coming into force - - 9th March 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road ("the A49"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Leominster and Ludlow, in the District of the County of Herefordshire and the County of Shropshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A49 Trunk Road (Leominster to Ludlow) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 9th March 2012.

2. In this Order -

"the trunk road" means the northbound and southbound carriageways the

A49 from its junction with the A4112 near Leominster to

its junction with the A4113 near Ludlow.

"the works period" means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 12th

March 2012 and ending when the said works have been

completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
  - **5.** The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-
    - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;

- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works; or
- (iv) proceeding in the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
