CIVIL AVIATION

The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Kemble) Regulations 2012

Made - - - - 12th March 2012

Coming into force - - 26th August 2012

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Kemble Aerodrome, Gloucestershire, by reason of the holding of flying displays that are scheduled to take place on 26th and 27th August 2012.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

- **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Kemble) Regulations 2012 and come into force on 26th August 2012.
 - **2.** In regulation 3 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.
- **3.**—(1) Subject to paragraph between 1000 hours and 1700 hours on 26th and 27th August 2012 no aircraft is to fly below 6,000 feet above mean sea level within the area of a circle having a radius of 3 nautical miles whose centre is at 514005N 0020322W.
- (2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying with the prior permission of the flying display director at Kemble Aerodrome.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Kemble, Gloucestershire by reason of air displays that are scheduled to take place there from 26th and 27th August 2012. A large number of civil and military aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres during the event. The Secretary of State, with the agreement of the Civil Aviation Authority and the Department for Transport, considers that flying should be restricted during the air show in the vicinity of Kemble for reasons of public safety.

In relation to the permission mentioned in regulation 3(2), the Kemble Air Show flying display director may be contacted on telephone 01285 771177.

Full details of the airspace restrictions will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
