ROAD TRAFFIC

The A27 Trunk Road (Oving Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

 Made
 19th March 2012

 Coming into force
 7th April 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed near the road:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Oving Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 7th April 2012.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A27 Trunk Road in the County of West Sussex;

"the northbound carriageway" means the northbound carriageway of the trunk road (Chichester By-pass) at its junction with Oving Road (B2144);

"the southbound carriageway" means the southbound carriageway of the trunk road (Chichester By-pass) at its junction with Oving Road (B2144);

"works" mean gas connection work near the trunk road; and

"a works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Tuesday 10th April 2012 or on any subsequent day until 6th October 2013.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle
 - (a) to turn right into Oving Road (B2144) from the northbound carriageway of the trunk road, or
 - (b) to turn left into Oving Road (B2144 from the southbound carriageway of the trunk road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
 - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;

- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
