ROAD TRAFFIC

The M40 Motorway (Junction 2) Southbound Entry Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

Made - - - - 21st January 2013

Coming into force - - 28th January 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M40 Motorway ("the M40") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those connecting roads in the County of Buckinghamshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the M40 Motorway (Junction 2) Southbound Entry Slip Road (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 28th January 2013.
- **2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 7 hours starting at 22:00 hours on Tuesday 29th January 2013, or on any subsequent day until work to install Motorway Incident Detection (MIDAS) loops in the carriageway of the motorway has been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the entry slip road to the southbound carriageway of the M40 at Junction 2.
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance, traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes.
