# The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Folkestone) (Revocation) Regulations 2013

 Made
 23rd May 2013

 Coming into force
 24th May 2013

The Secretary of State deemed it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Folkestone, Kent by reason of the holding of a flying display that was scheduled to take place there on 8th June 2013.

The flying display having been cancelled, the Secretary of State no longer deems it necessary to restrict flying in that vicinity on the day in question and makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

#### Citation and revocation

- **1.** These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Folkestone) (Revocation) Regulations 2013 and come into force on 24th May 2013.
  - 2. The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Folkestone) Regulations 2013(b) are revoked.
