The A46 Trunk Road (Bishopton to Marraway, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road ("the A46"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Bishopton and Marraway, north of Stratford-upon-Avon in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Bishopton to Marraway, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 8th April 2013.

2. In this Order –

"Bishopton Roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway of the A46 at its roundabout junction with the A3400, Birmingham Road, at Bishopton;
"Marraway Roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway of the A46 at its roundabout junction with the A439 at Marraway;
"the trunk road"	means the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A46 from its junction with Bishopton Roundabout to its junction with Marraway Roundabout;
"layby"	means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that

	carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 15th April 2013 and ending when the said works have been

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

completed;

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby adjacent to the westbound carriageway of the A46 approximately 300 metres northeast of Bishopton Roundabout.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave any side road situated adjacent to the trunk road.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
