The M1 Motorway (Junction 9) Southbound Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway ("the M1") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads in the County of Hertfordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junction 9) Southbound Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 6th May 2013.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 7 hours starting at 22:00 hours on Monday 13th May 2013, or on any subsequent day until works to replace message signs on overhead gantries have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the exit slip road from or the entry slip road to the southbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 9.

3. The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works or for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer or purposes.
