The M1 Motorway (Junctions 28 to 30) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

 Made
 21st May 2013

 Coming into force
 28th May 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway ("the M1") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that motorway and some of those connecting roads, in the County of Derbyshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and regulation 16(2) of the Motorway Traffic (England and Wales) Regulations 1982 (b), hereby makes the following Order:-

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junctions 28 to 30) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 28th May 2013.
 - 2. In this Order –

"the first length of motorway"

means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the M1 from a point 2000 metres south of the centrepoint of the southern overbridge if Junction 28 to the centrepoint of the southern overbridge of Junction 30;

"the second length of motorway"

means -

- i) the northbound carriageway of the M1 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 28 to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 30; and
- ii) the southbound carriageway of the M1 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 30 to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 28;

"the first lengths of slip road" means any slip road leading to or from the M1 at Junctions 28, 29 and 29a; "the second lengths of slip road" means the slip road leading i) to the southbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 30: and ii) from the northbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 30: means the Motorways Traffic (England and "the Regulations" Wales) Regulations 1982; "a hard shoulder" means the hard shoulder, within the meaning of Regulation 3(1)(e) of the Regulations, which is adjacent to the first length of motorway; "overall width" has the same meaning given in regulation 3(2) of the Road Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1986(a); "the works period" means the period starting at 00:01 hours on Monday 3rd June 2013 and ending when the

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

said works have been completed;

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on first length of motorway or the first lengths of slip road.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the first length of motorway, the second length of motorway, the first lengths of slip road or the second lengths of slip road.
- **5.** Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle with an overall width exceeding
 - i) 3 metres to enter or proceed in lane 1 of the first length of motorway; and
 - ii) 2.75 metres to enter or proceed in lane 2, 3 or 4 of the first length of motorway.
- **6.** The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
 - **7.** The provisions of:
 - (a) articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes, or

- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (b) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes; and
- (c) articles 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
- **8.** During the works period, regulations 5 and (in so far as it relates to a vehicle being driven) 9 of the Regulations are hereby suspended in respect of a hard shoulder, at such times and to such extent as may from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- **9.** The Secretary of State is satisfied that the execution of the said works will take longer than a period of eighteen months starting on the date when this Order comes into force.
