ROAD TRAFFIC

The A259 Trunk Road (East Guldeford Level Crossing) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

 Made
 28th May 2013

 Coming into force
 15th June 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A259 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (East Guldeford Level Crossing) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 15th June 2013.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A259 Trunk Road in the County of East Sussex;

"the length of trunk road" means the trunk road between points 30 metres north and 30 metres south of East Guldeford Level Crossing near Rye;

"works" means Network Rail level crossing work on the trunk road; and

"the works period" means a period of 10 hours starting at 2245 hours on Saturday 22nd June 2013 or on any subsequent day until 14th December 2014.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of trunk road.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -
 - (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
 - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform:
 - (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
 - (e) a vehicle proceeding in the length of trunk road to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that road to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
