ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1(M) Motorway (Junction 44 to Junction 42) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

 Made
 30th May 2013

 Coming into force
 9th June 2013

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1(M) Motorway and connecting roads, in the Districts of Leeds and Selby, in the Counties of West Yorkshire and North Yorkshire, is satisfied that traffic on that motorway and one of those connecting roads should be prohibited because traffic loop reinstallation works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order: -

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the A1(M) Motorway (Junction 44 to Junction 42) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 9th June 2013.
- **2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order, no person shall, during a period of 9 hours starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 10th June 2013 or any subsequent night thereafter until the said works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the:
 - (i) A1(M) Motorway southbound carriageway from the diverge of the M1 Motorway southbound carriageway at Hook Moor Interchange (A1(M) Motorway Junction 43 and M1 Motorway Junction 48) to the nose of the southbound entry slip road at Junction 42 (Selby Fork), a distance of 6700 metres; or
 - (ii) link road connecting the A64 Trunk Road westbound carriageway to the A1(M) Motorway southbound carriageway at Junction 44 (Bramham).
- **3.** The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works, or for traffic officer or winter maintenance purposes; or
 - (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
