ROAD TRAFFIC

The A2 Trunk Road (Boughton By-pass, Eastbound) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2013

Made - - - - 21st January 2013

Coming into force - - 9th February 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A2 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A2 Trunk Road (Boughton By-pass, Eastbound) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 9th February 2013.

2. In this Order:

"the trunk road" means the A2 Trunk Road near Upper Harbledown in the County of Kent;

"the length of carriageway" means the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road between points 330 metres west of its junction with Denstead Lane and 190 metres east of that junction;

"works" mean footway/cycleway repairs and all associated work on the trunk road; and

- "a works period" means a period of 9 hours starting at 2100 hours on Monday 11th February 2013 or on any subsequent day until 8th August 2014.
- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of carriageway.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- **5.** Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(**b**) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
