The A49 Trunk Road (Edgar Street, Hereford) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road ("the A49") is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road at Hereford in the District of the County of Herefordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed nearby:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A49 Trunk Road (Edgar Street, Hereford) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 6th May 2013.

2. In this Order:

"a bus"	has the meaning given in Regulation 22(2) of The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (b)
"pedal cycle"	has the meaning given in regulation 4 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002
"the works period"	means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Sunday 12th May 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle other than a bus or pedal cycle to turn right from the northbound carriageway of the A49 into Blackfriars Street; and

4. Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to turn right from the southbound carriageway of the A49 into Canonmoor Street.

5. The provisions of article 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable in uniform; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
