CIVIL AVIATION

The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No. 3) Regulations 2013

Made - - - 4th June 2013

Coming into force - - 9th August 2013

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of the places specified in column 1 of the Schedule by reason of the intended holding of flying displays there by a jet formation display team on various days between 9th August and 17th September 2013.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation, commencement and revocation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No. 3) Regulations 2013 and come into force on 9th August 2013.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

Restricted airspace

- 3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), during the period between 1000 hours and 2000 hours, at each of the places specified in column 1 of the Schedule, no aircraft is to fly within the corresponding area bounded by a circle having a radius of 6 nautical miles whose centre is at the point specified respectively in column 2, below the altitude and on the day specified respectively in columns 3 and 4.
 - (2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying—
 - (a) within controlled airspace if it flies in accordance with a clearance issued by the appropriate air traffic control unit, or
 - (b) within the aerodrome traffic zone of an aerodrome having an air traffic control unit if it flies in accordance with a permission issued by that unit.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in the locations and airspace specified in the Schedule during flying displays by the Royal Air Force Aerobatic Team, the Red Arrows and possibly other aerobatic display teams, which are due to take place during the period 9th August to 17th September 2013.

Flying restrictions are being imposed at the various sites in the UK listed in the Schedule for reasons of public safety and to protect the display teams. In view of the demanding nature of aerobatic display flying, the pilots involved cannot be expected to make unscheduled violent manoeuvres in order to avoid other conflicting aircraft. Any distraction caused by aircraft conflicting with the flight path of the formation risks a collision between display aircraft, or between display aircraft and other aircraft in the display area. These restrictions are therefore required in order to protect the display aircraft, other air traffic and spectators.

Details of the restrictions will also be published by AIC and NOTAM. Periods between 1000 and 2000 hours (UTC) on each particular day falling outside the actual display times will be subject to an exemption applying to all other aircraft complying with local air traffic control clearances or permissions.
