ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M1 Motorway and A46 Trunk Road (Kirby Muxloe,
Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - - *3rd June 2013*

Coming into force - - *10th June 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway (“the M1”) and the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of those roads and on one of those connecting roads at Kirby Muxloe in the County of Leicestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway and A46 Trunk Road (Kirby Muxloe, Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 10th June 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A46 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A50 Groby Road and Markfield Road, to its merge with the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 21a;

“a slip road” means the slip road leading to –

- i) the southbound carriageway of the A46 from the its roundabout junction with the A50 Groby Road and Markfield Road; and
- ii) the southbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 21a;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 17 June 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

(a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;

(b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable in uniform; or

(c) being used in connection with the said works.
