ROAD TRAFFIC

The A30 Trunk Road (Scorrier Junction to Chiverton Cross, Cornwall) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road ("the A30") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and one of those connecting roads near Redruth in Cornwall should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Scorrier Junction to Chiverton Cross, Cornwall) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 11th June 2013.

2. In this Order –

"the A30" means the eastbound carriageway of the A30 near Redruth from the tip of the nosing of the eastbound exit slip road at the Scorrier Junction to the southwestern edge of Chiverton Cross Roundabout;

"the slip road" means the eastbound entry slip road at the A30 Scorrier Junction, Redruth;

"tip of the nosing" means the last point where an exit slip road leaves the carriageway of a trunk road;

"the works" mean sign replacement works;

"a works period" means a period of 11 hours starting at 19.00 hours on Thursday 13th June 2013 or on any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A30 and the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

(c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works.
