ROAD TRAFFIC

The A30 Trunk Road (Turk's Head Junction, Honiton) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2013

 Made
 18th June 2013

 Coming into force
 22nd June 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road ("the A30") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on two of those connecting roads at the Turk's Head Junction, Honiton, in the District of East Devon in the County of Devon should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Turk's Head Junction, Honiton) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 22nd June 2013.

2. In this Order -

"the slip roads" mean (i) the link road at the A30 Turk's Head Junction, Honiton, from its junction with Exeter Road to a point 30 metres west of the A30 bridge parapet; and (ii) the westbound exit slip road at the A30 Turk's Head Junction, Honiton, from a point 20 metres prior to the end of the slip road to the end of that slip road;

"the works" mean works to form a new footway and development site access;

"the works period" means the period starting at 00.01 hours on Monday 24th June 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the slip roads.
- **4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:
 - (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.
- **5.** No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
