ROAD TRAFFIC

The A500 Trunk Road (Stoke-on-Trent, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

 Made
 17th June 2013

 Coming into force
 24th June 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A500 Trunk Road ("the A500"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the City of Stoke-on-Trent, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A500 Trunk Road (Stoke-on-Trent, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic)) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 24th June 2013.

2. In this Order –

"the trunk road"

means -

- the northbound carriageway of the A500 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to Whieldon Road to its junction with the entry slip road leading from the A52/A5006 (Shelton Old Road /Stoke Road) Interchange; and
- ii) the southbound carriageway of the A500 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to the A52/A5006 (Shelton Old Road /Stoke Road) Interchange to its junction with the entry slip road leading from the A52/A5007 (Church Street/City Road) Interchange;

"the works period"

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 1st July 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
