## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A43 Trunk Road (South of Brackley, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A43 Trunk Road ("the A43"), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road south of Brackley and in the County of Northamptonshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), hereby makes the following Order:-

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A43 Trunk Road (South of Brackley, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 24th June 2013.

## 2. In this Order –

"Barley Mow Roundabout"		the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout a of the A43 with the A421 and B4031;		
"Brackley Roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A43 with the A422 and Oxford Road;			
"Evenley Roundabout"	means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A43 with Broad Lane;			
"the trunk road"	means –			
	i)	the northbound carriageway of the A43 from Barley Mow Roundabout to Brackley Roundabout; and		
	ii)	the southbound carriageway of the A43 from Brackley Roundabout to Barley Mow Roundabout;

"layby"	means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (a) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;
"the works period"	means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 1st July 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the trunk road.

**4.** Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby situated adjacent to the -

- i) southbound carriageway of the A43 approximately 380 metres north Evenley Roundabout;
- ii) northbound carriageway of the A43 approximately 500 metres south of Evenley Roundabout; and
- iii) southbound carriageway of the A43 approximately 980 metres south Evenley Roundabout.

**6.** Subject as mentioned in articles 7 and 8, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave Evenley Roundabout or any side road at its junction with the trunk road.

**7.** The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

8. The provisions of –

a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;

- b) articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 shall not apply to any vehicle -
  - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
  - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and
- c) articles 4, 5 and 6 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
