**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A50 Trunk Road (Findern to Aston on Trent) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

*Made* - - - - *24th June 2013*

*Coming into force* - - *1st July 2013*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A50 Trunk Road (“the A50”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road and four of those connecting roads, between Findern and Aston on Trent in the County of Derbyshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A50 Trunk Road (Findern to Aston on Trent) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 1st July 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road”

means -

- a) the eastbound carriageway of the A50 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to its roundabout junction A38 (Toyota Interchange) to its junction with the link road leading from southbound carriageway of the A6; and
- b) the westbound carriageway of the A50 from its junction with the link road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A6 to its junction with the entry slip road leading from its roundabout junction with the A38 (Toyota Interchange);

“a slip road”

means the slip road leading to –

- a) the eastbound carriageway of A50 from its roundabout junction with the A514 near Chellaston;

---

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1

---

- b) the westbound carriageway of the A50 from its roundabout junction with the A514 near Chellaston; and
- c) the eastbound carriageway of the A50 from its roundabout junction with the A38 (Toyota Interchange);

“the link road” means the link road leading from the southbound carriageway of the A6 to the westbound carriageway of the A50;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Friday 5th July 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road, a slip road or the link road.

**4.** The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

**5.** The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
